We started the 3rd incarnation of 'Parched Lands' in Novembers 2020. Helen worked with our Junior writing group on zoom sessions and then in person. We did an online scratch performance in July 2021.

Then this year the final script was created working with the young people as writers & performers.

The young people felt a strong connection and empathy with the main character and the story. The play is about climate change and about how the worry of the future affects young people's mental health.

But, despite the serious subject, we've had fun!
