Forum Theatre & workshop

What's it about?

The play is about reputation, expectation, peer pressure and about how hard it is to make 'the right choice' when you are 16 years old.

The play (35 minutes)

Dani is in year 11, GCSE Year. He has moved to a new school right in the middle of term. He knows no-one and no-one knows him or what happened before... or so he thinks.

The workshop (45 minutes)

In the workshop that follows the young people get a chance to help Dani make some different choices, changing the outcome. The workshop uses the fiction of the play to explore bullying, stress at school and peer pressure.

Audience / workshop participants

We can perform to a class or a year group. But can only accommodate 1 class in the workshop.
